International Transcript Evaluations

Students who have earned college level work from outside the United States, regardless of their citizenship, are required to have their transcript evaluated by a NACES' accredited (National Association of Credential Evaluation Services) evaluation service. NACES is an association of private, foreign, educational credential evaluation services. NACES members judge the educational qualifications of the applicant based on appropriate reference materials and educational documents provided to them.

The evaluation completed by NACES and submitted by the student to Lees-McRae College must include a general evaluation as well as individual class and cumulative grade point averages (GPA) based on U.S. equivalences on a 4.0 scale. In addition, the coursework must be evaluated to be equivalent to four-year Bachelors level coursework from a regionally accredited university in the United States.

The following is a list of NACES' accredited members who perform transcript evaluations. Applicants must notify one of the transcript evaluation services listed below (applicants can choose whichever transcript evaluation service that they would like to utilize, including a service not listed below, if the service is NACES' accredited). Please Note: Lees-McRae College does not evaluate international transcripts; if an applicant is not satisfied with the transcript evaluation which is performed by an evaluation service, the applicant has the right to commission another transcript evaluation service (making certain that all transcript evaluation services which are utilized by the applicant are accredited by the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services). We will use whichever evaluation report that applicants instruct the college to use which the application materials are sent to the Admissions Committee.
