



Graduate Dental Fund Guidelines

New Opportunity School for Women at Lees-McRae College

If you wish to apply for funds for **dentures or partials**, you must follow these procedures:

1. Contact the New Opportunity School for Women **first** to inquire about the availability of funding.
2. Talk with your local dentist who would be doing the work and ask him/her to send directly to us an estimate of work to be done. If you submitted an estimate in the past and did not receive a grant, you must re-submit an estimate.

If you are a graduate and live in the vicinity of Banner Elk, NC, there is a local dentist who works with NOSW graduates:

Please note that assistance may or may not be available pending funds in the NOSW Dental Fund.

3. Prepare a letter from yourself stating why you wish to apply for the Dental Fund and the amount you wish to apply for. If the amount you are applying for is different from the amount the dentist estimates, please explain why that will be. Also, if you can pay a portion of the dental cost, you should also indicate that in your letter.
