Two students will be selected to receive a \$2,000 scholarship that is renewable as long as the student remains enrolled at Lees-McRae College in good academic standing with a minimum of 3.0 GPA and declared Humanities major of English, history, or religious studies. Scholarship is stackable with other Lees-McRae institutional aid.

Criteria:

- Students must apply to the college, be admitted and complete the Humanities Scholarship application by February 15, 2026
- Students must have a 3.0 GPA or higher
