

Presbyterian Scholarship

2026–27 Application

The Lees-McRae Presbyterian Scholarship, valued at \$2,000, is awarded to Lees-McRae students who have been an active member of the Presbyterian Church congregation for a minimum of four years. Selected students must demonstrate participation in church and community service. Application materials (including application, essay and reference evaluation form) must be submitted by February 15, 2026.

This scholarship is renewable as long as the student remains enrolled at Lees-McRae in good academic standing with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and can provide a letter from a pastor at a local Presbyterian Church indicating regular involvement with that congregation and participation in at least 20 hours of service per semester to that congregation.

Required Application Materials

Completion of all admissions requirements and acceptance to Lees-McRae College
Resume of participation in church-related and community service activities with a description of the activity and any leadership roles related to these activities. Include work in your local congregation, presbytery, synod, national church, or church-related organizations such as scouts, church camps, or other community groups.
One-page essay answering the question: What does it mean to live out my faith?
One letter of recommendation from the pastor of your home congregation OR a youth group or project leade with whom you have worked
A signed commitment on your part to continue your regular involvement with a PC congregation during your time at college and to take an active role in campus-based community service projects.
